LETTER FROM THE PRINCIPAL



Dear Readers.

This Advent I have enjoyed reading Sally Colin-James' *One Illuminated Thread*. This novel intertwines the stories of three women: in the time of Herod, Elizabeth yearns for child; in Renaissance Florence, the wife of a painter of *The Visitation* struggles to find the perfect white paint and in contemporary Australia, a textile conservator restores a tapestry of the Visitation. These stories of resilience, creativity and hope in the midst of yearning, suffering and oppression reflect the call of Advent – to wait actively with hope, peace, joy and love for the coming of Christ. This Advent Season we particularly pray for the coming of the Prince of Peace into our world as the war in Gaza continues, the number of refugees and displacement people across the world grows and as a world community we struggle to make decisions about living on the planet in a sustainable way.

Enrolments for semester one 2024 are now open and a full listing of University of Divinity

units offered at St Francis College is available below. We have a new offering, with the Rev'd Assoc. Prof. Matthew Anstey (who is currently working on a new translation of the Psalms) teaching a unit on the Psalms with an intensive March 1-2 followed by Tuesday evening webinars. When auditing (attending classes for no credit) with the University of Divinity, participants have access to the online teaching materials and an enrolment process needs to be completed with our Dean of Students, Dr Sheilagh O'Brien to take up this great opportunity to study the Psalms.

The Young Adults Retreat will be held in February and I encourage you to invite and perhaps sponsor a young person from your community to attend.

The Graduate Certificate in Research Methodology https://divinity.edu.au/courses/graduate-certificate-research-methodology/ provides a pathway for this as well as for M.Phil. and Ph.D.

If you are looking for Lenten Study materials, I recommend *God's Own Country*, the 2024 ABM Lenten Study in which "First Nations leaders and clergy from the Anglican Church generously offer theological insights and personal reflections that help us to hear the VOICE of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people of faith." https://www.abmission.org/resources/studies/. 
